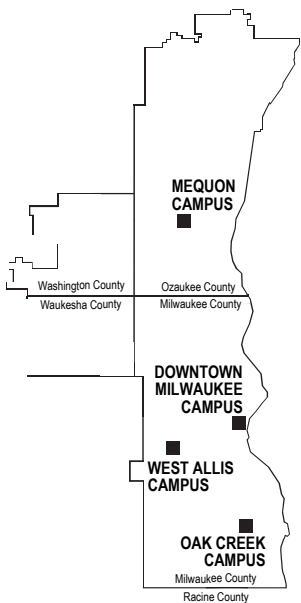

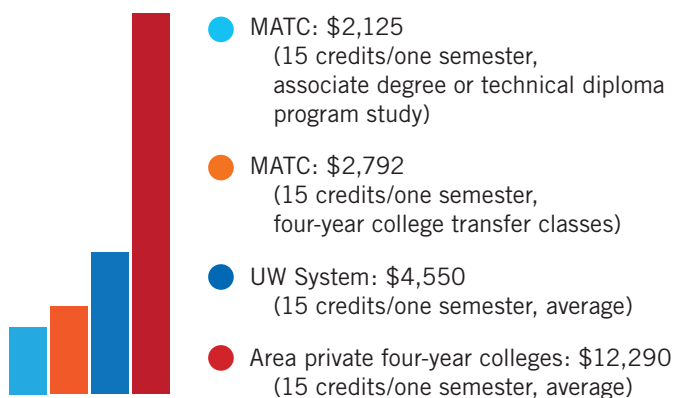
Online	23 programs	nine associate degrees, 12 technical diplomas and two certificates are offered entirely online and hundreds of online courses are available in many programs
